FLIGHT FOR LIFE RECEIVES PRESTIGIOUS CAMTS (COMMISSION ON ACCREDITATION OF MEDICAL TRANSPORT SERVICES) ACCREDITATION FOR THEIR MEDICAL HELICOPTERS AND GROUND AMBULANCES

FLIGHT FOR LIFE is now the only CAMTS accredited ground ambulance in the region

Waukesha – June 21, 2019 – The Commission on Accreditation of Medical Transport Systems is proud to announce that Flight For Life, a rotor-wing and ground ambulance transport service in southeastern Wisconsin and northern Illinois, was awarded accreditation on June 19, 2019. This honor recognizes Flight For Life’s dedication to exceptional patient care and commitment to safety both in the air and on the ground.

Having initially received accredited in 1996, Flight For Life was the first program in Wisconsin to achieve CAMTS status. In October 2018, Flight For Life expanded its resources by adding three ground ambulances to their fleet of two medical helicopters. The inclusion of the ground ambulances to the CAMTS accreditation means Flight For Life ground ambulances are the only ambulances to be CAMTS accredited in southeastern Wisconsin.

“We are honored to once again be recognized by CAMTS for the care we give our patients,” explained Flight For Life Executive Director Dan Burns. “The accreditation of our fleet of ground ambulances illustrates our level of commitment to all the patients we care for. I am exceptionally proud of our team of nurses, critical care paramedics, EMT drivers, communication specialists, and pilots who provide exemplary care, both in the sky and on the ground.”

CAMTS is an organization of non-profit organizations dedicated to improving the quality and safety of medical transport services, with 21 current member organizations each of which sends one representative to the CAMTS Board of Directors. The Commission offers a program of voluntary evaluation of compliance with accreditation standards demonstrating the ability to deliver service of a specific quality, with a strong focus on patient care and safety of the transport environment.
