Teri Campbell has been a flight nurse for 20 years and flies for the University of Chicago, UCAN program. She has an extensive clinical background, including high-risk OB, pediatrics, emergency, trauma, critical care and flight/transport. She is a Director of a statewide cardiac arrest improvement project called Illinois Heart Rescue (ILHR). In 4 years, ILHR has quadrupled out of hospital cardiac arrest survival and has tripled bystander CPR response for the state. She has authored numerous publications related to high-risk OB, pediatrics, cardiac, and transport topics. She has lectured at regional, national and international conferences.
